

College Internships

IDOC offers internship programs for both undergrad and graduate level students. Internships are available at multiple facilities throughout the state in varying disciplines.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. How long is the placement process?

A. Up to 3 months, including background and documentation review.

Q. How will I know if I've been offered an internship?

A. We will contact you and your academic advisor with further instructions after receiving all required documentation.

Q. Is this a paid or unpaid internship?

A. IDOC offers paid and unpaid academic internships that allow you to earn credit toward your degree. Contact the IDOC Internship Coordinator for availability.

Q. What are citizenship requirements?

A. You can be a citizen or a non-citizen with right-to-work authorization documentation.

HOW DO I APPLY?

- Contact IDOC Internship Coordinator, DOC.Internships@Illinois.gov & provide your preferred location and subject of discipline.
- Complete & return required documents.
- Wait for the facility to contact you to schedule an interview and tour.
- Confirm your acceptance.
- Complete background check, paperwork and orientation.
