<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>6</sup> A new offense violation is defined as an adult readmitted from criminal court for a felony committed while on MSR or parole.

 $<sup>^{7}</sup>$  A technical violation is defined as an adult on MSR or parole readmitted because of an MSR or parole rule violation.
