<sup>9</sup> County of Residence is defined as the county the parolee resides in as of the date of this report, it is not necessarily

the county where the parolee is released to nor the county where the parolee was convicted and sentenced. <sup>10</sup> *Total* does not include parolees residing in other states, or parolees who have been deported back to their home country.
