⁷ Other is defined as an adult and MRX parele readmitted because of an MRX parele violation, readmitted with new charges pending.
⁷ Other is defined as an adult admitted to IDOC custody for something other than an MRX Parele violation, including admission from other custody or violation of some other form of release.
